LEARNING SPOTLIGHT

This week Year 5 had a visit from the Fire Safety officer who also spoke about road safety. We were reminded of the need to have smoke alarms in our homes and to check these regularly. We learnt about making an 'Exit Plan' in the event of a fire at home and this week the children are drawing maps of their homes to show their escape plans for the whole family.

The children were reminded of safe places to cross the road; they looked at different scenarios and discussed the dangers and risks of not using the correct crossing facilities.
